COMMUNITY INTEREST COMMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 551.0415 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE

Councilmember Cayten – Not present for comments.

Councilmember Bass – Thanked those who tuned in to the meeting, commenting he hopes it won't be much longer before people can start coming inside the Council Chambers. With upcoming inauguration of a new President, hopes all will get along in this country, unite and get past the COVID and get our economy back on track. Wished all a blessed 2021.

Councilmember Schoenbein – Welcomed audience to Council Meeting. He had the honor of attending the 78th Police Academy Class Graduation. Discussed the many "firsts" that occurred for this class. Extended congratulations to the cadets who graduated, commenting they will make Pasadena a safer city. Thanked President Trump for his leadership over the last four years. Also, praying for President Biden and asked that everyone will lift him and our country up in prayer. Stated that our country needs to unite and be the "shining example that our nation has always been".

Councilmember Ybarra – Passed; no comments.

Councilmember Leamon – Extended thanks and congratulations to the graduating cadets of the Police Academy. Dr. Victor Simms – Chief of the Department of Internal Medicine and Immediate Past Managing Physician at the Kelsey-Seybold Clinic in Pasadena.
