



TEAM UP TO CLEAN UP PROGRAM 2021

The **TEAM UP TO CLEAN UP PROGRAM** is a program that was created by the City of Pasadena, Neighborhood Network and the Pasadena Industrial Community Network. In partnership with community, business and industry leaders, civic organizations, churches, schools and individuals who have a desire to help others in need. We assist senior citizens, disabled veterans, persons with disabilities and low-income homeowners with exterior home repairs and improvements, as well as yard clean up and debris removal. TU2CU volunteers have successfully visited neighborhoods across Pasadena, and together we have been able to improve the health, safety and quality of life for our residents.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE PROGRAM?

This program was designed to assist homeowners who are in the greatest need of assistance and are unable to perform the necessary work themselves. Application will be review on a first come first serve basis. Certain guidelines must be met before a homeowner will be considered eligible for assistance through the program. Senior citizens over age 62, disabled veterans, persons with disabilities and low-income homeowners that meet the income eligibility based on the HUD annual guidelines for very low income limits may apply.

To determine if you are eligible for this program, please fill out and submit the attached application and a representative from the City of Pasadena will contact you to discuss your eligibility.

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

Once it is determined that a homeowner meets eligibility for the program, the request will be submitted to the TU2CU Committee. The TU2CU Committee will make the final determination of the projects that will be chosen. As TU2CU is a volunteer based program, there is no guarantee that your home will be selected. There is also a possibility that only a portion of the items requested will be completed due to the limitations of our volunteer organizations. A representative from the City of Pasadena will contact you to discuss your situation, schedule an assessment of your property, and answer any questions you might have about the program.

On the day of the event, projects will be dispersed to volunteer organizations who have partnered with the City of Pasadena to assist with the program. Volunteers include industry, business, civic organizations, churches, schools and individuals who have a desire to help others in need.

PHASE II – Habitat for Humanity has graciously agreed to assist some homeowners who are in dire need of assistance based on funding availability. There is a possibility that your project could be picked up by other affiliated volunteer organizations. **If your home is selected by Habitat for Humanity (Phase II) or another volunteer organization, your project will no longer be any part of the City of Pasadena's TU2CU Program, and the City of Pasadena will not accept any responsibility or liability for the outcome of your project.**

HOW DO I APPLY?

Please read the program guidelines carefully before completing application. This information is kept strictly confidential and will be used only to verify eligibility.
