### Suspect Arrested During an Alleged Murder-for-Hire Plot

On November 30, 2016, at approximately 6:00 p.m., investigators from the Pasadena Police Department's Detective Division arrested 63-year-old Clarence Michael McNatt for an alleged murder-for-hire plot. Pasadena Detectives received information in early November of 2016 that McNatt was attempting to hire someone to murder a 31-year-old female. Two undercover Pasadena Detectives were assigned to pose as hitmen in the case and through their efforts, charges were filed on the suspect for Conspiracy to Commit Capital Murder and two counts of Conspiracy to Commit Aggravated Kidnapping with Intent to Commit Sexual Assault. It was also learned through the investigation that the suspect worked as a police officer during the 1980s and 90s for three separate police agencies in Texas (Houston P.D., Ames P.D, and Clear Lake Shores P.D.). McNatt was arraigned in Harris County Court #262 earlier today where he was denied bond. He is currently being held in the Harris County Jail awaiting trial.

There will be a press conference held today at 4 p.m. in the Pasadena Police Department's Community Room located inside the main police station at 1201 Davis Street, Pasadena, TX. 77506.
