On our city website, www.pasadenatx.gov/coronavirus you can get information about Pasadena facility closures or any updates regarding hours and services. There are also links to the national coronavirus website, the state hotline, Harris County Public health and our city social media accounts.

Information about presumptive and positive COVID cases is maintained by Harris County Public Health. They work with the state to determine where testing sites are most needed and are in charge of all cases. My team and I are in constant communication with Harris County Health and they have assured us that they will let us know if Pasadena is affected.

On our website, business owners will also find a Local Business Impact survey. This will help us with federal recovery funding.
