Eligibility Criteria

- 1) Applicant must be either a junior or senior in high school.
- 2) Applicant must submit two reference letters with their application as well as proof of their grade point average.
- 3) Background check: No person with a Class A misdemeanor or higher conviction, including a Family Violence conviction, shall be allowed to attend the class. A Class B misdemeanor conviction has a 10 year disqualification period. All disqualifiers shall remain concurrent to and consistent with the Texas Department of Public Safety's TCIC/TLETS ACCESS POLICY, or any additional policy amendments.
- 4) You will be automatically disqualified if you have any outstanding warrants or pending court dates in either Municipal, State, or Federal courts. You will not be allowed to attend the Citizen Police Academy until such warrants are cleared, and all cases are adjudicated.

The Junior Citizen Police Academy is a 10-week course designed to give students a better understanding of the Pasadena Police Department. Applicants must be either a junior or senior in high school.

Classes will be held once a week (Monday evenings) from 6:00 pm – 9:00 pm in the Pasadena Police Academy (6052 Genoa-Red Bluff Rd). Each week a different area of the Police Department is covered. This course of study will cover topics such as crime lab, juvenile investigations, DWI, police pursuits, SWAT and crime scene investigations. Classes will consist of lectures, demonstrations and hands-on practice.

We will help you understand how we do our jobs, why we do things in a certain way, and how you can help us to serve you better. You will visit different areas of the police department and see it as few other citizens have. You will have the opportunity to personally meet and talk with many officers throughout the department. We hope the graduates of the Junior Citizen Police Academy will take their new knowledge into the community and educate others when the opportunity arises.
