#### **Homicide - 1607 Locklaine Dr.**

At approximately 12:53 am this morning, our dispatch center received a call from a man stating that his brother had been shot in the face and was lying in the roadway. Our officers immediately responded to the residence, where they found the victim, 37-year-old Rojelio Ramirez Jr., unresponsive with a gunshot wound to the head. He was transported via Life Flight to Memorial Hermann, where he was later pronounced deceased.


As a result of the initial investigation, we received information indicating that the possible homicide suspect is Eric Ray Cano W/M 8/9/82. We were able to obtain corroborating information and subsequent evidence implicating Cano as the shooter in this case.

Cano has been charged with Murder in the Harris County 338th Criminal District Court. Cano's current location is unknown; however, he was last seen driving a Maroon 2014 GMC Truck with Texas license plate KNV-8764.
