Officer Involved Major Crash - 6200 Almeda Genoa

On Saturday, October the 10th, at approximately 12:40 pm, one of our police sergeants was involved in a major collision in the 6200 block of Almeda Genoa in Houston. The sergeant, a 25-year veteran of the Pasadena Police Department, was in uniform and on his police motorcycle at the time of the incident. A witness at the scene observed the crash and stated that he watched as the motorcycle and another vehicle approached one another in opposite directions on Almeda Genoa. The witness further stated that the other car started to turn left in front of the sergeant's motorcycle and that the sergeant attempted to alert the other driver by sounding his siren; however, the driver continued turning into the path of the motorcycle. The sergeant is currently being treated at Memorial Hermann Hospital, where he is listed in stable condition. The crash is being investigated by the Houston Police Department, and any inquiries relating to the investigation should be forwarded to the investigating agency.
