Homicide - 4214 Rainfall Dr.

On August 25, 2021, at approximately 3:46 am, our dispatch center received a call from a man who had awakened to find his wife had been shot and was unresponsive. Our officers immediately responded to the residence, where they began administering aid to the female victim, who was later identified as 81-year old Brooksie Worsham. Mrs. Worsham ultimately succumbed to her wounds and would later be pronounced deceased by medical professionals. The male caller later told police that he did hear gunshots earlier in the morning before he called 9-1-1; however, he stated that he had lost consciousness, and it was determined that he too had suffered at least one wound from gunfire.

Earlier this same morning, at approximately 2:43 am, our dispatch center did receive a call from a citizen stating that they had heard several gunshots in the area. Although officers responded to investigate, they did not observe any suspicious activity at that time.

During the initial investigation, detectives observed a broken window in the back of the residence along with shell casings on the ground just outside of that same window. This window led to the master bedroom of the home where both victims had been at the time of the shooting. While our Detectives were canvassing the neighborhood for information, they were able to obtain surveillance video of a vehicle entering the subdivision shortly before the incident. It was later determined that the vehicle's registered owner was linked to another active investigation involving the male victim in this case.

As a result of the information obtained from the scene, Jack Monroe Beck W/M 11/12/01, was identified as the possible perpetrator. Investigators were then able to obtain corroborating information and subsequent evidence implicating Beck as the shooter in this case. Subsequently, a warrant was issued for Beck's arrest.

As this investigation continued to unfold, the Gulf Coast Violent Offenders Task Force, in collaboration with the US Marshalls and the Louisiana State Police, were able to locate Jack Monroe Beck this morning just outside of Baton Rouge, where he was taken into custody without incident. The suspect remains confined and is now awaiting extradition back to Texas.
