



FAQ's Matching Grant



- 1. What is the Neighborhood Matching Grant Program?**

It is a reimbursement program for all recognized neighborhoods within the City of Pasadena to beautify the community & improve the quality of life, public health, and welfare in the neighborhood.
- 2. Who benefits from the program?**

The citizens of the recognized neighborhood and the entire City of Pasadena benefit from the program.
- 3. Who is eligible to apply?**

Any recognized neighborhood who meets regularly with current board members, & have established by-laws is eligible to apply.
- 4. Can I start a neighborhood organization?**

- 5. How many grants can the organization apply?**

Neighborhood organizations may submit up to four applications. Three projects and one National Night Out event.
- 6. What are the steps to apply?**

Ensure you are a recognized organization through the City of Pasadena, by updating all information through our office, and complete the Matching Grant application.
- 7. What are the rules/requirements for a project?**

Each project has to comply with city ordinance 2018-044 which constitutes a public purpose. It cannot serve just to a gated community.
- 8. Who approves the projects?**

Projects are reviewed and approved by a Grant Board Committee.
- 9. What is the maximum reimbursement from each project?**

Maximum amount for each project is \$7,500, the grant will reimburse up to 50% of project cost.
- 10. When can you apply?**

Applications may be submitted in January through mid- February. Dates are to be determined each year, and will be available on our website.
