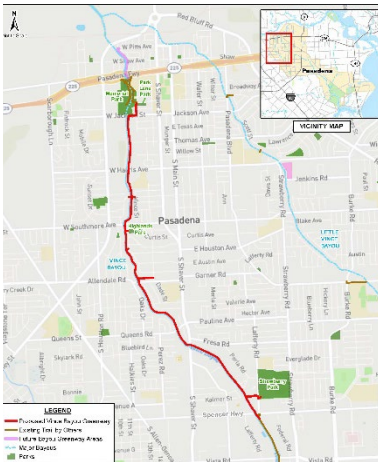

MEETING OVERVIEW

The City of Pasadena, Pasadena Parks and Recreation Department, and Pasadena Economic Development Corporation hosted an open house to provide an update on the Vince Bayou Greenway project. This proposed trail along Vince Bayou will connect Pasadena's Memorial Park to Strawberry Park and is in the first phase of design. A brief presentation by the project manager, Houston Parks Board, was followed by an open house where attendees shared feedback on design options via display boards. Spanish-language services firm, Tecolotl, provided in-person Spanish interpretation, and at least five attendees participated primarily in Spanish. Families were also welcomed with children's activities and a light dinner being provided to attendees.

COMMUNITY INPUT

POLL RESPONSES

78% of attendees live within the Pasadena area. They heard about the open house primarily through Facebook (44%). Others heard about it from friends and family (20%), e-mail (12%), and flyers (8%)

BOARD FEEDBACK

Fitness Equipment: Both obstacle course equipment (45%) and traditional exercise equipment (55%) were strongly supported by attendees.

Butterfly: Pipevine Swallow Tail (36%) and Monarch (30%) butterflies received the greatest amount of support. Other species surveyed were Cloudless Sulphur (14%), Gulf Fritillary (14%), and Buckeye (6%)

Wall Material: Attendees were interested in both Concrete Masonry Unit/Concrete Blocks (CMU) (53%) and concrete (47%)

CMU Tone: The preference was for a cool tone (60%) over a warm tone (40%)

Concrete Pattern: Attendees' favorite concrete pattern was Saale (65%). Other pattern options were Thur (18%), Columbia (12%), and Jamaica (6%)

OTHER QUESTIONS/COMMENTS – TEAM RESPONSES IN GREEN

Will there be lighting along the greenway?

There will be lighting at the greenway entrances to adjacent neighborhoods but not along the greenway.

Will there be security cameras?

No, but adjacent homeowners are welcome to put up their own cameras along their property line. We are coordinating closely with the police, so they are aware of this coming greenway.

When will the future phases of the greenway be completed?

A timeframe cannot be provided because the future phases are based on available funding. However, we understand a completed and connected greenway is a better-used greenway.
