

Information: Clean Streets Task Force

This type of Community Service MUST BE COURT ORDERED to receive community service hours!

YOU MUST PRE-REGISTER IN PERSON, YOU CAN NOT DO IT OVER THE PHONE

THINGS YOU WILL NEED TO PRE-REGISTER:

- **COURT PAPERS**
- **IF YOU ARE UNDER 18 YOU WILL NEED A PARENT TO BE PRESENT**
- **IF YOU ARE 17 AND NO LONGER IN SCHOOL YOU WILL NEED TO BRING PROOF:**
 - **IT CAN, BE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA, GED OR WITHDRAW PAPERS.**

Items You Need To Know:

1. The City of Pasadena Clean Streets Division is a separate department from the Pasadena Municipal Courts. The Clean Streets Task Force provides a service to the Pasadena Municipal Courts, and the surrounding courts (except for Houston Municipal Court), to allow the defendants to do community service hours that have been ordered by a Judge.
2. Clean Streets Task Force accepts defendants from ages ten (10) to eighty (80) depending on physical ability.
3. Children 13 years of age and younger (or up to and including 8th grade) do not need to have a photo ID.
4. Adults and students in 9th grade or higher are required to show their school ID every time they come to work.
5. **Our service is only provided to those that have been ordered by the courts to do community service.**
 - a. We do not provide services for high school students or any other organization.
6. Tasks: All defendants are supervised by a Clean Streets crew leader.
 - a. Women and minors walk and pick up litter throughout the City.
 - b. Men, 18 years and older, mow grass and weed-eat.
7. We do not accept pregnant women that are four (4) months or more along.
8. We do not provide trash grabbers -- you can bring your own. **(WE DO NOT ALLOW THE POKER STICKS WITH A NAIL OR SPIKE ON THE END!)**
9. We do not accept defendants that are on workers compensation to work until you have been released by their doctor and can provide proof of release.
10. You must comply with all rules and regulations from Clean Streets to complete your hours or you will be expelled from the program and must pay the remaining balance of your fine plus state fees.
11. If you are required to take medication throughout the day it must be in its original prescription bottle and you must show your immediate supervisor upon arriving in the morning for work.
