

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

Clinical Health Services

TB Elimination, W.I.C., HIV & STD Prevention, Dental, Expanded Mobile Health, Health and Wellness Clinics/Mobile

In an effort to meet the essential healthcare needs of Harris County residents, **we provide a variety of low-cost clinical services in a patient-centered environment.**

Uninsured (younger than 65 years)



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Tuberculosis (TB) Elimination

TB is an infectious disease caused by a bacteria and it most commonly affects the lungs. It is transmitted from person to person via droplets from the throat and lungs of people with the active respiratory disease. TB causes more deaths than any other infectious disease worldwide and infects one-third of the world's population.

Program overview: Tuberculosis (TB) Elimination offers a variety of services aimed at TB prevention and control at the HCPH Antoine clinic.

Services:

- Testing (detects LTBI and Active TB) (**\$25.00 one-time payment for testing**)
- Evaluations
- Chest X-rays,
- Case management, and medication.
- These services are under the direction of a physician who – along with nurses and other TB Program staff – helps carry out the local fight against TB.

Patients must schedule an appointment for eligibility and need to be enrolled in either the Healthy Texas Women or Family Planning program.

HIV & STD Prevention

The HIV and STD Prevention Program provides clinical services, education, and counseling at the Antoine location.

Services:

- PrEP or pre-exposure prophylaxis to prevent getting HIV
- Testing for HIV, syphilis, genital herpes, HPV, and viral hepatitis
- Treatment for patients with HIV/AIDS

We travel anywhere in the Greater Harris County and Montgomery County area to provide HIV and syphilis testing along with condoms, lube, and dental dams

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Dental- Clinics

The **HCPH Humble** and **Southeast** clinic locations provide dental services for **children, adolescents, and expectant people who meet the eligibility requirements.**

Services:

- Dental examinations, X-rays, cleanings, fluoride treatments, tooth sealants, diet and oral hygiene counseling, fillings, pulpotomy, stainless steel crowns, extractions
- **Our clinics accepts those who have Medicaid and CHIP.**
- Many uninsured patients are seen at our clinics at no cost or at a minimal cost to the families because they qualify for the Title V grant.
- New patients are encouraged to call for an appointment.

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

The Harris County Public Health clinics provide a variety of **free or low-cost clinical and preventative health services** to meet essential healthcare needs for those who meet the eligibility criteria.

Program Services:

- Family planning services
- Screening for diabetes, high blood pressure (hypertension), and high cholesterol
- Screening and treatment for Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs)
- Screening for postpartum depression
- Cervical cancer screening (Pap smear)
- Clinical breast exams and mammography referrals
- Immunizations for children and adults

Adult Wellness Exams & Family Planning Services

**Services based on eligibility*

The purpose of the Expanded Mobile Health Unit is to prevent illness caused by vaccine preventable diseases. This is a fully mobile operation with front desk and clinical staff that travels to schools, churches, community centers, etc., to provide **immunizations and wellness screenings**

Services:

- Childhood vaccines (0-18)
- Adult vaccines (19+)
- Flu vaccines (September to February)
- Blood pressure screenings

Eligibility:

- School-age children who are uninsured, or enrolled in Medicaid/Chip
- Adults who are uninsured

Lead Prevention Program

The Harris County Lead Prevention Program is committed to reducing lead poisoning of children in Harris County.

Services

- Provides educational outreach to the public on the dangers and prevention of lead poisoning
- Provides free Testing to community.
- Informs health care professionals of recommendations and requirements for lead testing
- Lead testing at Baytown, Humble, Fallbrook, and Bear Creek WIC locations
- Case coordination for children with elevated levels of lead, to identify the lead source and ensure the poisoning discontinues.

SNAP (Food Benefits)

Helps families and individuals to buy food for good health.



Healthy Texas Women (Ages 15 - 44)

Helps women pay for health exams, screenings, and birth control.



TANF (Cash Help)

Helps pay for food, clothing, and housing costs for families with children 18 years or younger.



Harris Health Financial Assistance Program Harris

County's **healthcare** financial assistance for low-income Harris County residents.



Health Care (Medicaid, Medicare, CHIP)

Helps pay for medical bills and medications.



The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP)

Government program that helps many low-income households pay for broadband service and internet connected devices.

3. Free COVID/Flu vaccines and COVID testing through HCPH (832) 927-8787: ***May 11 End of the Public Health Emergency***
 - Coverage for COVID-19 testing and treatment will now vary by insurance type.
 - COVID-19 vaccines will continue to be free for all, as long as the supply of federally purchased vaccines lasts.

4. CDC continues to recommend that everyone stays **up-to-date on COVID-19 vaccinations**, take a test if you have symptoms or have been exposed, and wear a high-quality mask when COVID-19 levels are high.
