Attempted Kidnapping

On April 4, 2022, a male subject driving the vehicle depicted in the photograph below attempted to lure two juvenile females into his car in Pasadena.

The man was described as a white male in his twenties with medium-length brown hair and a stubble goatee. In both cases, the man asked for directions and then asked the juveniles to come closer, stating that he could not hear the answer. In one of these cases, he displayed a handgun and threatened harm to one of the girls if she did not comply with his request. Both of these incidents occurred in the general area of Red Bluff Road and Preston Avenue.

It was later discovered that a male subject matching the description above had attempted to coerce an additional juvenile female into his vehicle in Deer Park earlier this same day. The vehicle in all three cases was described as a dark grey 4-door sedan, possibly a Honda Civic, with black rims and a sunroof.

Parents should remain vigilant and remind their children not to talk to strangers or enter a vehicle of anyone they do not know.
