Aggravated Robbery Suspects Arrested

At approximately 9:15 pm on Friday, September 25, 2020, a Pasadena Police officer working proactive surveillance observed a silver Chevrolet Impala with paper plates enter the parking lot of the Family Dollar in the 2100 block of Richey St. This vehicle matched the description of a suspect vehicle involved in numerous Aggravated Robberies committed throughout the Pasadena and Houston area over the past several weeks.

Our officer immediately radioed for additional marked units. While waiting for back up to arrive, he observed the passenger exit the vehicle and enter the Family Dollar. A short time later, the suspect exited the store and entered the waiting vehicle. Marked units then converged on the suspect vehicle and attempted to make contact. The passenger then fled on foot with a gun in hand. Our units immediately set up a perimeter, and with the assistance of the Houston Police Department's Fox Helicopter Division and South Houston Police Department's K9, he was taken into custody without incident. The driver of the vehicle was also taken into custody without incident.

In the previous robberies, the suspect(s) would park either across the parking lot or at a nearby lot before one of them would enter the business on foot. The suspect entering the business would then display a black semi-automatic handgun and demand money. He would then flee on foot and leave in what several witnesses described as a silver 2000-2005 Chevrolet Impala. He was seen by witnesses exiting and entering the passenger side of the vehicle before fleeing the scene leading us to believe there was another suspect involved.

Charges are pending in this case.
